



Pacific Peoples' Partnership - Request for Qualifications / Proposals

Pacific Peoples' Partnership (PPP) is seeking a Vancouver Island based professional / contractor specializing in strategic planning to help facilitate a hybrid planning process with our board, staff and key stakeholders to sharpen our focus, address operational challenges and guide the work of our organization into the future.

The Request for qualifications deadline is March 12, 2021.

Goals:

1. VISION: To facilitate a strategic visioning process for PPP that aligns with the 2030 Global Sustainable Development Goals.
2. FOCUS: To help PPP ground our work with findings from our recent Pacific Islander / partner needs assessment.
3. OPERATIONALIZE: To assist PPP in a strategic review of our mission, mandate, and governance. With the aim to create a five year action plan that addresses capacity and stakeholder participation.

Deliverables include:

- Background research that includes a review of PPP and our work, past strategic plans, activities and operating structures, SWOT, plus identification of systemic challenges;
- Grounding the planning process with interviews with key members of our team along with a review of findings from the Pacific Islander needs assessment;
- Design and plan for a hybrid offering of virtual and in person (if allowed) strategic planning sessions/workshops with our PPP Team (board, staff, and key stakeholders);
- Draft a 2030 vision statement and 5-year work plan grounded within PPP priorities, capacity and stakeholder needs;
- Facilitate a process for engaging feedback on the draft plan, incorporating recommended changes as endorsed by PPP team;
- Deliver and finalize the PPP 2030 vision and 5-year action plan.

Ideal contractor:

- Experienced strategic planning professional / consultant;
- Deep understanding of working with Indigenous peoples, plus local and global development experience;
- Experience working with non-profit, NGO and charity organizations.
